The backbone of our Network-as-a-Service infrastructure

The Bayobab fibre network has 16 substantial subsea fibre cables that wind their way ashore at landing stations connecting to key national points to promote local content within countries.

From there, Bayobab's terrestrial network branches out over 114,000 km, linking 47 international points of presence across Africa. Bayobab fibre forms Africa's most significant fixed connectivity infrastructure and is expanding to reach 135,000 km of proprietary fibre by 2025. The network incorporates Data Centres for Cloud Computing and other ICT services, delivering Metro Fibre to businesses and feeding tens of thousands of terabytes of data into our central Bayobab Communication services platforms.

Bayobab Footprint



Bayobab Voice

The Bayobab Voice platform carries all voice telephony to and from MTN in 18 countries across Africa. As Africa's primary voice carrier, we work with MNOs, telecom aggregators, digital service providers, global conferencing providers, and OTTs to deliver a secure and superior voice experience within and between Africa and the rest of the world. Our services include International Bi-lateral Voice, International Hubbing Voice, and Cloud Numbering Services (CNS).



Bayobab Roaming

Using a central GSM and Open Connectivity compliant platform, Bayobab facilitates International Roaming between Mobile Network Operators and elected Roaming Partners. Services include GSM roaming, wholesale roaming, roaming added-value services, IoT, and M2M roaming.



Bayobab Messaging

Our centralised SMS platform monetises and secures incoming and outgoing SMS services. These include Peer-to-Peer (P2P), Peer-to-Application (P2A), and Application-to-Peer (A2P) messaging, which remains the most reliable and ubiquitous point of reach for authenticating mobile end users. Bayobab Messaging analyses and filters unsolicited SMSs, corrects onward routing, and provides proactive insights on traffic while providing a single direct connection point to all 18 MTN mobile operators and additional direct reach to other local African operators to deliver the highest quality SMS connections in the market.



Bayobab IPX

Using the Bayobab IPX platform, mobile operators can create a secure, future-proof network to contain and reduce costs while introducing new interconnect and roaming services. These next-generation services include IoT, VoLTE, ViLTE, RCS, VoWiFi, and services that help to improve the Quality of Experience for our subscribers with intelligent policy configurations.
